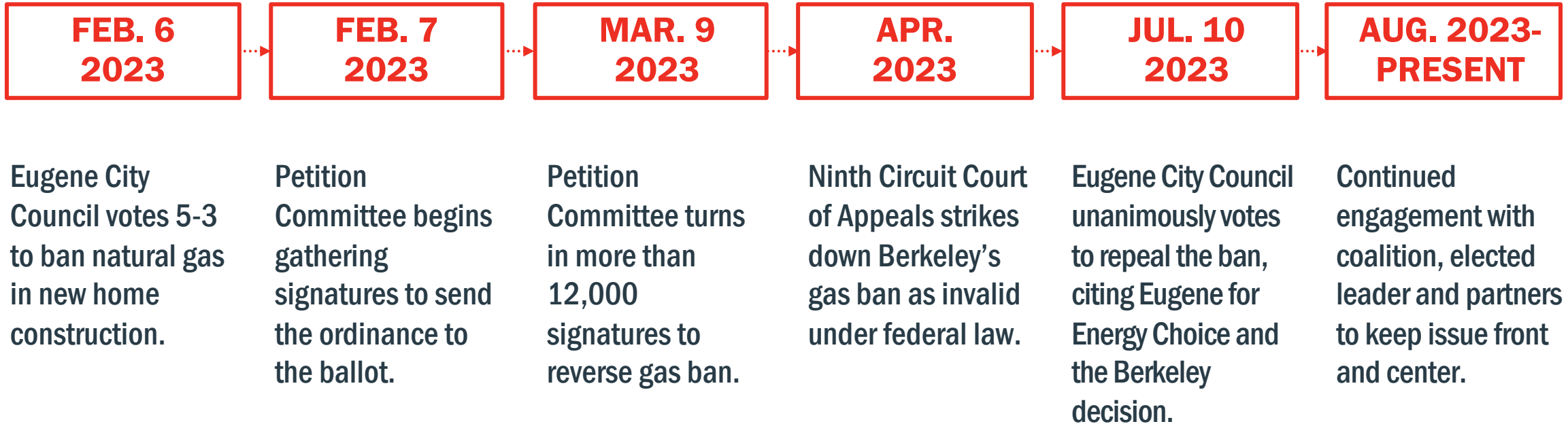
WHAT WE DID TO ENGAGE THE COMMUNITY
